

Parish Pastoral Council Meeting Wednesday, October 17th, 2018

Meeting was called to order by Joni Starzec; Crystal Hamling led the opening prayer. Roll call showed all members present. Fr. Ross added discussion of the snow removal contract under New Business, and Tim Vetick added discussion about the PA system in the Social Hall under New Business as well. Motion was made by Amy Sliva to approve the agenda; the motion was seconded by Kerry O’Kane. A motion was made by Tim Harrington to approve September meeting minutes, with Tim Vetick seconding the motion.

Committee Reports

Finance Committee – Frances Veseth reported on income and expenses for the month of September. **PRE** - Lori Olson provided a report; PRE classes began on September 12th, and there are currently 116 students enrolled for the year.

St. Anthony School Board – Tim Harrington reported; in-service topic covered a Blend-Ed program being implemented this year.

Maintenance – Ryan Kudron reported; there is a light needing to be replaced over the Green Fiber dumpsters. Tim Vetick reported also that the concrete/drainage projects are still in the works.

Pastor’s Comments - Fr. Ross reported; there have been four baptisms, three deaths, one marriage, one new parishioner, and six members have left.

Old Business

Evangelization - Fr. Ross reported; Monday meetings have been going very well. Karen and Hannah Merrill provided information about Stubenville and JC Camp and the positive impacts on faith formation.

Lifetouch Directory – Fr. Ross reported; working on the rest of the parishes in town. Still expecting the directory to be ready around January.

2018 Bazaar – Fr. Ross reported; raffle ticket sales have been down this year compared to last by about \$2000. Prizes for the stands are ready, but donations for big-ticket items have been down some. Still need some help hauling items on Saturday morning. There will be a follow-up meeting in November.

Parish Regrouping Meeting – Fr. Ross reported; a meeting was held on October 6th; St. Anthony’s and St. Stanislaus’ parishes are ahead of the game in terms of figuring out Mass schedules. There will be a Deanery meeting in December.

Archdiocese Annual Appeal – Fr. Ross reported; we’re at about 58% of our financial goal, and a little under 7% for participation.

Other – Tim Vetick reported; he took eight screens in to Columbus Door & Window for repair.

New Business

Proposed Capital Campaign – Fr. Ross reported; we should look at a campaign to anticipate future needs. May form a steering committee to plan.

Snow Removal – Fr. Ross reported; received a contract from Bierman Contracting for snow removal.

PA System – Tim Vetick reported; wouldn’t work for an event in the social hall. May need to look at updating/repair.
