Ross added one item to the evening's agenda under new business. Amy Sliva motioned to approve, and Ryan Kudron seconded. A motion was made by Tim Vetick to approve August meeting minutes, Kerry O'Kane seconded.

### **Committee Reports**

**Finance Committee** – Frances Veseth reported on income and expenditures for the month of August.

**PRE** – No report.

**St. Anthony School Board** – The council reviewed school board minutes from the month of May.

**Maintenance** – Ryan Kudron and Tim Vetick reported; hoping to work on concrete repairs this fall yet. Eight screens will need to be replaced on the rectory windows.

**Pastor's Comments** – The month of September saw three baptisms, two deaths, and no marriages. St. Anthony's welcomed three new parishioners and deleted four parishioners.

**Evangelization** – Fr. Ross reported; the evening of prayer meetings (first and third Mondays of the month) have been going well.

**2018 Bazaar** - Fr. Ross reported; many thanks to the O'Kane's for co-chairing the bazaar! Workers' list is being sent out to everyone; will need help hauling everything back to church after the bazaar is over.

**Parish Regrouping Meeting** - Fr. Ross reported; a meeting will be held on September 27<sup>th</sup> to discuss scheduling Masses, holy days, confessions, etc. for St. Stanislaus in Duncan. A draft will be then sent to the Archbishop for approval.

**Archdiocese Annual Appeal** - Fr. Ross reported; a rep from the Archdiocese will be speaking at this weekend's Masses about participation in this year's appeal.

**Brainstorm New Ideas** - Fr. Ross reported; will wait to discuss at October's meeting.

**Other** – Fr. Ross reported; looking into having a missionary speaker talk about evangelization one night; possibly have him come for a weekend sometime in January if it goes over well.

**Other** - Tim Vetick reported; the empty storage container that held bazaar supplies (now in the garage at the new parish center) will be used to store items from the basement of the school. It is a designated tornado shelter and needs to be cleaned out to accommodate the kids.
